Inspired by the perseverance of our members and in the spirit of the *Salon de la Refuses* of 1863, ‘Unsinkable Spirits’ gives us an opportunity to showcase those of our works that didn’t get accepted into a show, with a special interest towards those pieces that were accepted into a subsequent show.

Realizing that newer members who have never entered juried shows would not be accepted into this show, by default, they now qualify for this show. Just stay on theme and show us those of your paintings which most clearly represent your creative initiative and your tendency to never give up.

‘Unsinkable Spirits’ has exceptions to our normal guidelines. Pieces may already have been exhibited in a SAWG show and entries completed over two years ago are still eligible. All other show presentation standards still apply.

Artist may provide up to 2 images of entered artwork to be used for publicity purposes. Images should be labeled with the first four letters of the artist’s last name, the number of the entry as it appears on the entry form, and a short title. They should be in jpeg format, 300 dpi, no larger than 1800 pixels on either direction. File size should be less than 2Mb. Example: Mary Smith’s painting, A Day at Sandy Beach, should be labeled smit1dayatbeach.jpg. Send images to images@southernazwatercolorguild.com.
