

Let's Experiment – Supply List

Provided:

- Collage Papers
- Watercolor substrates for Mini-Collage & Yupo Papers
- Gesso – White and Black; Gouache – White and Black
- Masking Tape
- Exacto Knife, Scissors, Cutting board
- Foam rollers (not cloth); Brayer
- Water soluble crayons & pencils
- Stencils, Stamps, Plexiglass
- Adhesives – Yes! Paste and Golden Acrylic Glazing Liquid Satin Finish
- Cold Wax
- Ecofriendly Reusable Towels; Phone Book; Wax Paper
- Composition Demo Board
- Sand Bags; Boards
- Straight Edge; Ruler

Participants must bring:

- (2) paintings that need help/rescued/or something completely different. Any size.
- Pigments: Tube paints – Not squeezed out. Any colors.
- Brushes: Stiff craft or nylon brushes that can be used for adhesive.
 - (1) Size 6, 8, or 10 round
 - (2) Different Sized 1/2, 3/4 or 1 inch flats.
 - You can also apply adhesive with a plastic card or popsicle stick. Do NOT bring any fine art or high-quality brushes for this workshop.
- Palette
- (1) or (2) water container(s)
- Small jar/container with a tight lid
- Scissors

Optional: You may bring anything that is on the provided list if it is easy for you to pack into your art supply bag. You do not have to buy any of the products for this class.

Sessions:

We will be working 3 hours each day starting with a brief demonstration. Everyone will have time to work on their own art. Each Session will build on the previous session.

- **Session 3:** Yupo Review and Development; Rescue Painting Review and Collage Development; JT Collaboration Work
- **Session 4:** Cold Waxing Yupo; Wax or Varnish and Mounting Collages; Completion of JT Collaboration Work
