

Supply List*

Paper: Any good watercolor paper will do! I prefer using Arches 140 lbs. cold press paper.

Paint: Any brand of professional watercolor paints. I like to use M. Graham watercolor paints.

Brushes: Use the brush you are most comfortable with. I prefer using a round #16 or #14 watercolor and a small #3 rigger brush.

Palette: Use any palette with large wells.

Other essentials: Tracing paper, carbon paper, pencil, eraser, masking tape, a board to place underneath your painting, large container for water, paper towels, any personal reference materials and an expectant happy heart!
