

## Tracy Lynn Ross - Supply List

A palette, water containers, box of tissue and paper towels, and a small spray bottle.

### 2 Canvases 9x12 or larger

- Option 1 - a ready to paint watercolor canvas - **Yes** all media artist canvas, or **Fredrix** Archival watercolor canvas.
- Option 2 - Prime a standard canvas with watercolor ground - **Daniel Smith** watercolor ground, **Golden** makes Absorbent Ground, and **Schmincke** has AQUA primer fine.

### Paints

- Artist quality paints are a must! No student grade please. I use mostly **Daniel Smith** watercolors.
- A warm and a cool of each of the primary colors will be good plus any of your favorite colors.

### Brushes

- Use whatever brushes you are comfortable with. I will use **Mimik** watercolor brushes #14 and #8 round, #2 rigger, and a ½" cat's tongue for a 9x12 painting. Reminder the larger the canvas the larger the brushes you will need. You will also need a synthetic flat or angle brush #8 or ½" that can come to a nice sharp edge for lifting.
