Open to all services - active duty, National Guard, Reserve or retired. Documentation is required and listed on the entry form.

Application deadline is July 19, 2019. One or two pieces of artwork may be entered. Entry fee is \$26 for one piece or \$37 for two pieces. The first 70 entries will be accepted. After that entry checks will be returned.

The artist may provide images of entered artwork to be used for publicity purposes. This is not required. Images should be labeled with the first four letters of the artist's last name, the number of the entry as it appears on the entry form, and a short title. They should be in jpeg format, 300 dpi, no larger than 1800 pixels on either direction. Example: Mary Smith's painting, A Day at Sandy Beach, should be labeled smit1dayatbeach.jpg. Artwork will be delivered to the gallery at 5420 E. Broadway, #240 on Wednesday, July 24, 9 – 10:30am. If the artist is unable to meet this date, arrangements can be made for an earlier delivery.

All two-dimensional or three-dimensional media, with the exception of giclee prints or material copied from sources not the artist's own, are accepted. This includes photography, painting, collage, assemblage, sculpture, woodworking, pottery, ceramics and fused or stained glass. All materials of construction are acceptable.

Three-dimensional artwork that cannot stand alone on the floor must be accompanied by a pedestal. Three-dimensional work that can hang on the wall cannot be too heavy to be hung without harming the wall.

All work should be presented in a professional manner that is appropriate to the work and should be clean, dry and wired ready to hang. Sawtooth hangers are not accepted. If framed under glazing, glass may be used if it does not exceed 36 united inches (height plus width). Anything larger must be glazed with Plexiglas or finished entirely with a varnish over artwork and mat, if present.

Work on canvas that is  $\frac{3}{4}$ " in depth must be framed. Gallery-wrapped canvas at least  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " deep must be finished on all sides and does not need to be framed. No staples can show.

Artwork cannot exceed 42" on any side or be smaller than 10" on any side including frame.

A label should be attached to the back of the work that includes the artist's name, the title of the work, contact information for the artist, and the price. The price must match the entry form. No changes can be made after the entry deadline.

SAWG Gallery will retain a 25% commission on any artwork sold. The gallery will handle all sales and sales taxes. The artists will receive a check within six weeks of the close of the show for any and all sales.
