FOR STUDENTS:

Submit 1-2 pieces of your art work; 2 pieces must be submitted to qualify for a \$1000 award.

Artwork may be in any of the following mediums: watercolor, acrylic, oil, graphite, pen and ink, pastel, colored pencils, collage, or mixed media. All art submitted must be original. Copied or duplicated images, including computer generated art or images copied from magazines or someone else's photographs will not be considered. Art work is not required to be framed, but matting is recommended as presentation is one of the judging criteria.

Judging criteria will include sense of design, composition, technical skill, originality, handling of materials, presentation, and visual expression/impact.

Complete and bring the Application for the 2017 SAWG Art Student Scholarship with your artwork, documentation cards, and parent permission form. Attach a documentation card to the back of each piece of art work.

WHEN: Saturday, March 18, 2017. Drop off artwork from 10:30-11:30am on Saturday. Pick up from 3:00-4:00pm the same day.
